# Elul Reflection Calendar

Elul is the last month before the Jewish new year. Our tradition instructs us to do *cheshbon ha'nefesh*, accounting of the soul. Psalm 27 is traditionally said every day in Elul. Each Sunday, read the offered verse and the corresponding reflection question. Take time during the week to journal, meditate, pray, or focus your practice on the questions. On Shabbat, find a friend to share your reflections with.
