“But if our marriage should be terminated by decree of the civil courts and if by expiration of six months after such a decree I do not give you a divorce according to the laws of Moses and the people of Israel (א גט), then our betrothal (קידושין) and our marriage (נישואין) will have been null and void.”

The bride replied to the groom: “I consent to the conditions you have made.”
