Questions

Before reading the text: Review the guestions so they can guide your listening.

As the text is being read: Listen with curiosity, wonder, clarification.

After reading the text: Once you've read the text and enjoyed food and song, discuss the questions together.

- 2. What do you want to know more about?
- 3. For this passage to be fulfilled, what is your hope or dream?
